



NRHA.DK FDM Reining program

Futurity-Derby-Maturity

The Danish FDM program, contains Futurity for 4 year old, Derby for 5 year old and Maturity for 6 and 7 year old horses.

It is possible to pay the horse into the program from the day it is born and all the way up to 7 years of age. To be eligible to participate in these prestige's events, with a big payout of prize money, the horse can be paid in by the following schedule

Prices for enrollment of horses in FDM program:

Foal: DKK 500

Yearlings: DKK 1.000

2 year olds: DKK 1.500

3 year olds: DKK 2.000

4 Year old and older: DKK 2.500

Last date for paying in to the above-mentioned prices is 31. December and has to be done at least 8 days before the show. Money will not be refunded and must be paid into account: reg: 7240 account number: 1441646, with a note of the name of the horse.

All horses payed in, will receive a certificate.

The payout system will work as such: 40% to the Futurity, 30% to the Derby and 30% to the Maturity. There will be a deduction of 1.500 DKK for administration fee. Entry fee minus 50% (judge fee etc.) will also be paid out with the prize money. The payout schedule follows the NRHA pay out system A.

Entry fee

Entry fee level 2: 800 DKK, - Level 1: 500 DKK, must be paid on the entry form for the show. Please note that entry fees are liable to change. Refunds of entry fee will follow regular show rules.

Rules

NRHA handbook of rules and drug policies apply as well as the regular show rules, for the specific show. The horse must have a NRHA competition license or NRHA.dk registration. Owner and exhibitor must be member of the NRHA.dk at the time of enrollment as well as the time of entering the specific show. The FDM program is divided in level 1 and 2. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to enter the correct level. Riders that has won less than 2000 USD are eligible for level 1. Riders that has won more than 2000 USD are ONLY eligible for level 2. Lifetime earnings from NRHA and other reining associations count to which level the rider is eligible to enter. NRHA.dk reserves the right to ask for info regarding lifetime earnings in connection with entering FDM classes. All NRHA.dk members can check their NRHA and NRHA.dk earnings on the website of www.nrha.dk.

In case of a rider shows In level 1, but is not eligible to do so, there can be made a written protest to the show office within 14 day after the class, as long as they can provide evidence.

A level 1 rider can enter both level 1 and 2, however they must pay entry fee for both levels.

The FDM classes is run over 2 go-rounds and the winner is determined on the combined scores from both go-rounds. Level 1 and 2 is run concurrently and therefore a horse cannot show in both levels with 2 different riders.

The winning rosette sash is given to the first placed horse in each level along with a trophy in level 2 and a plaque in level 1. There will be rosettes down to third place.

NRHA.DK Futurity.

Open to 4 year old horses, it will be ridden by the NRHA rulebook, however the horse is allowed to be shown in a snafflebit on 2 hands. 40% of the pool belonging to the particular year group, plus entry fee minus 50% retainage, will be paid out for prize money. Distribution is 30% to level 1 and 70% to level 2.

NRHA.DK Derby.

Open to 5 year old horses, it will be ridden by the NRHA rulebook, however the horse is allowed to be shown in a snafflebit on 2 hands. 30% of the pool belonging to the particular year group, plus entry fee minus 50% retainage, will be paid out for prize money. Distribution is 30% to level 1 and 70% to level 2.

NRHA.DK Maturity.

Open to 6 and 7 year old horses, it will be ridden by the NRHA rulebook. 30% of the pool belonging to the particular year group, plus the entry fee, minus 50% retainage, will be paid out for prize money. Distribution is 30% to level 1 and 70% to level 2.
